



Media, Brands and Real Stories

How Cadbury used media and communication to recover from the worms case.


Which is the first brand that comes to your mind when you think about chocolates? Cadbury Dairy Milk. There are so many flavors and variants like Fruit and Nut, Silk and Bubbles etc.

We say to the shopkeeper "Bhaiyya ek Cadbury Dena", without realizing that the Cadbury is the brand name and not the product category. The product category is Chocolate, right?

So Cadbury is a British multinational company founded in 1824 having headquarter in Greater London, which operates in more than 50 countries worldwide.

With respect to India, it controls more than 70% of the chocolate market with a presence in 1.2 million stores. Cadbury has had to develop chocolate consumption in India as a cultural habit for over 60 years.

But it hit its biggest roadblock in India in October 2003, in a controversy just a month before Diwali, where customers in Mumbai complained about finding worms in Cadbury Dairy Milk chocolates. As a consequence, the Maharashtra Food and Drug Administration seized the chocolate stocks manufactured at Cadbury's Pune plant.





Quick to respond, Cadbury issued a statement that the infestation was not possible at the manufacturing stage and poor storage at the retailers was the most likely cause of the reported case of worms. However, the FDA alleged that "The packaging was not proper and airtight, so it was a manufacturing defect with unhygienic conditions and improper packaging."

How Cadbury used media and communication to recover from the worms case.

This controversy resulted in decline in Cadbury's sales by 30%, at a time when it used to see festive spike of 15%. For the first time Cadbury's advertising went off air for a month and a half and it had an impact on consumers as they seemed to ignore their chocolate cravings. This was the time they realized the gravity of the situation their company might be facing, as their brand value started seemingly decreasing. As the Brand was under fire, it launched an initiative called project 'Vishwas'.

They invested Rs.15 crore on imported machinery, it revamped the packaging of dairy milk by using metallic poly-flow which was costlier by 10-15%, but did not hike the price.

All these efforts were made to regain customer confidence.

But what worked the magic was what the company did in January, 2004.





They roped in Amitabh Bachchan as a brand ambassador to do the Brand Endorsement, which was risky because it put his personal equity on the line for the brand. In the ad, he was seen personally taking us through the Cadbury factory assuring its high manufacturing standards to consumers. Simultaneously the ad expenditure were upped by 15%.

Company also issued a statement, "We believe that to be a responsible company, consumers need to have complete faith in products. So even if it calls for substantial investment and change, one must not let the consumer's confidence erode."

The recovery began soon as Cadbury claimed that consumer's confidence was back.

The consumers were more forgiving, as the brands' message through media created a positive connect which resulted in creating an emotional equity in India.

So, what we understand through this case study is, how media created and sustained Cadbury's brand image in consumer's minds, as it helped it to recover from distress and brought about a positive impact for the brand "Cadbury" and the power that media yields in the minds of consumer.
